# {FROM THE CHAIR}

It's often said that everyone in Salem has three occupations. Take me, for example. I'm a father, doctor, singer (or at least I like to think so). I'm also a volunteer for some wonderful community organizations like the Salem Hospital Foundation.

When the Foundation was founded 40 years ago by citizen volunteers interested in advancing health care through donations, they probably couldn't have imagined their idea would grow over the years to become an organization that raises millions of dollars, and helps thousands of people in our community.

Hospital trustees filed articles of incorporation for a Foundation on May 25, 1967, and within a month, Southern Pacific Railroad had contributed \$2,500 and Daniel Fry Sr. had given 82 shares of stock in Illinois Central Industries.

The Foundation made its first grant on Aug. 22, 1968. It was a \$500 scholarship to help Rose McGrory enroll in the nursing program at Salem Tech, which later became Chemeketa Community College.

This year, as the Salem Hospital Foundation celebrates its 40th anniversary, we awarded \$111,000 in scholarships to 89 students in Marion and Polk counties. You can read about one of those students, Kristin Faber, in this publication.

You can also learn more about the Painter Sisters.

They had a number of interesting occupations, but one in particular helped them leave a mark on our community, and that is "philanthropist."

I hope when you look over our annual report, you'll notice a common theme – the Foundation is really about people helping people.

So no matter what your many occupations, whether you're a carpenter, musician, parent or chef, we hope you'll consider adding one more to the list – donor.

Soon the Foundation will be embarking on a capital campaign, as we work to provide the necessary health care facilities for our community. And we can use everyone's help.

Since she was old enough to pull on her rubber boots, Kristin could be found out in the barn at her West Salem farm feeding the cows. And by the time she graduated from high school, she had helped birth calves, give vaccines and "work 24/7" when needed, because "that's just what you do when you live on a farm."

But even though farming is in her blood, Kristin is dedicating her life to a different profession. When she was six, her beloved grandfather died of cancer. That event had a lasting impact on Kristin, and sparked her interest in nursing.

Kristin, a straight-A, second year nursing student at Pacific Lutheran University, received a \$1,000 scholarship from the Salem Hospital Foundation. She plans to get her Bachelor of Science degree, then possibly continue her education and become a Certified Nurse Practitioner. She also might like to teach, or volunteer in underprivileged areas of the United States and other countries.

"I went to Mexico on a mission when I was 14, and three years later spent another couple of weeks in the Dominican Republic," said Kristin. Both times her group was working with poverty and rural health care issues. "It's interesting to see how health care professionals in those places make do without adequate supplies and money...they appreciate what they have, and rely more on giving their personal care to patients."

Kristin has seen how both parts of medicine are equally important — the professional care, as well as the personal attention. With the memory of the wonderful nursing care her grandfather received still etched in her mind, she works hard to make room in her schedule so she can spend some "one-on-one" time with the patients she comes in contact with during her clinical training.

And thanks in part to the funding provided by the Salem Hospital Foundation, she has a little extra time in her schedule.

"I'm so appreciative to the Foundation, because the scholarship has taken such a burden off my life, and has allowed me to concentrate on academics, and not have to have a second job."

In 2006, the Foundation awarded \$111,000 in scholarships to 89 students from Marion,
Polk and Yamhill counties who were enrolled in a medical or medically related field. Since the Foundation's scholarship program began in 1968, over \$1.1 million

dollars has been awarded.

# {LEAVING A LEGACY}

In their youth, Phyllis and Prudence Painter roamed a large farm that is now downtown Keizer. The family business, called Painter's Woods, revolved around Clydesdale horses that were sold for use in logging and agriculture. Among the children's pals was a cousin, Sally Bush, naturalist and heiress to the pioneer family that brought professional banking and journalism to Salem.

The sisters spent most of their adult life away from Salem, but both moved back later in life. Prudence was married to a professional golfer, and lived in California for many years, and Phyllis and her husband owned Bend's popular Pilot Butte Inn during a time when it was a destination for U.S. Presidents and film icons.

"They were inseparable," said Sarah Rinehart, the sisters' attorney and close friend for 25 years. "Always impeccably dressed in wool suits, white gloves and hats, the ladies were very prim and proper," she added.

Phyllis and Prudence's love of the Salem community is shown through their generous bequests, with more than \$300,000 given to the Salem Hospital Foundation, as well as donations to St. Paul's Episcopal Church, the Salem Pioneer Cemetery and the Willamette Humane Society.

Their gift to the Salem Hospital Foundation was specifically designated for the hospital's neonatal intensive care unit (NICU).

"They were explicit about how their estate would be used," said Rinehart. "It's important to detail specific desires when preparing a charitable bequest, because you want to make sure the receiving organizations can actually use the funds in the way your clients wish."

When the Painter sisters announced their intention to donate part of their estate to neonatal intensive care, it was 1994, and the hospital had yet to develop such services. Due in part to their foresight and generosity, Salem Hospital's NICU is now helping save infants that would have had little hope of surviving 50 years ago.

With funds from the sisters' gift, a number of pieces of equipment have been purchased for the NICU, including an aEEG monitor that monitors an infant's brain function, and a Giraffe OmniBed, an enclosed incubator with advanced features for premature newborns.

"No doubt it would please the ladies to see the results of their gift," said Rinehart.



Arrhythmia is a disruption in the heart's normal electrical system, triggering an irregular heart beat.

And according to Robert Estrada, Salem Hospital's Cardiovascular Services Manager, it's a common ailment in people over age 50.

Until recently, blood thinning and heartslowing medications were the primary methods of controlling arrhythmia.

But thanks to equipment purchased with a \$125,000 grant from the Salem Hospital Foundation, various types of arrhythmia can now be quickly identified, mapped and often cured, without the need for medication.

"The hospital's capital budget was tight, and I knew the Foundation provided assistance to worthwhile projects that help advance medical care in our community," said Estrada. "Without the Foundation funding, we couldn't have purchased the new equipment, and implemented the improvements."

The Electrophysiology Mapping System provides the medical team with multiple sources of vital, real-time information from the patient's heart. This information is displayed on three computer screens while the electrophysiologist guides catheters to the site of the problematic cells, and then neutralizes them with high frequency radio waves. This procedure is referred to as cardiac ablation.

Before getting the new system, the Electrophysiology Department was doing about four ablations per month, with older, less sophisticated equipment. And nearly all of those cases were not complicated.

"With the new equipment, we can more than triple the number of cases we're doing, and we can also now take care of the more complex cases as well," said Estrada.

The demand for this procedure is rapidly increasing, and Robert believes the hospital will need to add a second electrophysiology suite in the near future.

"Being able to stay in Salem for this procedure instead of going to Portland is

a huge benefit for people throughout the

Willamette valley," said Estrada.

And according to Robert, the new equipment has provided a great deal of satisfaction for not only the physicians and staff who work with it, but also for the patients receiving treatment.

"It's great to be able to offer this level of excellent care and service to heart patients right here in our own community."

# The Heart of the Matter


